



- All students will have daily live interaction with their teachers via Zoom
  - Whole Group
  - Small Group (Cohorts)

#### Material Pick-Up Procedures:

- While on campus please adhere to all CDC guidelines at all times, including:
  - Maintaining 6 ft. distance
  - Wearing a mask
- Families will enter campus at the designated gate at the designated grade level time and proceed to the outside of their student's classroom (there will be a school representative to direct you)
- · All hallways and classrooms will be closed
- Materials will be in a bag on the bench outside of the classroom (be prepared to carry books, school supplies, etc.)
- Chromebooks will be available for pick-up in the valet line during all material pick-up times



#### Food Distribution

- During full distance learning, the WUSD lunch program will (again) take place only at Dana Middle School between the hours of 11:30am to 1:00pm.
- This is a grab and go program only. Whereas last spring all students were given lunch at no cost, this school year students will be charge based on their status (free, reduced, full cost).
- **Cost per lunch:** 
  - > \$3.45 for TK-5
